Prayer and spiritual dynamics of ministry, missions, and church growth are key emphases of Acts considered in this course.

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## ABOUT THE LECTURERS

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### **DR. JIM RION, D.Min**

Founder and Lead Pastor of Westover Hills Church, Pastor Jim D. Rion is known for his leadership, vision, and passion for developing people. In 1986, just two years after he was ordained with the Assemblies of God, Pastor Jim and his wife Denise poured all their resources into starting Westover Hills Church. Though it began in a rented storehouse with just a few people attending the first service, the church is now positioned on a 42-acre campus with a thriving, diverse congregation of more than 5,000. Because of its exponential growth, the church has made Outreach Magazine's annual list of the Fastest Growing churches in America for five years.

In 36 years, the foundational element of Pastor Jim's vision for the church has remained the same. Westover Hills Church is all about Making New and Making Great, which describes leading people to a new life in Christ and helping them experience the great life that comes with loving and serving God. It is the underlying message in all of Pastor Jim's sermons and teachings, which not only challenge people to pursue lives of purpose but also offer hope and encouragement through God's grace.

In pursuing his life of purpose, Pastor Jim has earned a master's degree in Biblical Literature and completed his Doctor of Ministry with the Assemblies of God Theological Seminary.

Also, he and Denise have raised two daughters.

Pastor Jim teaches organizational leadership on the Masters and Doctoral levels at Assemblies of God Theological Seminary. He also serves the South Texas District of the Assemblies of God as the General Presbyter on the national board and the Board of Regents of Southwestern Assemblies of God University. He regularly speaks to pastors, church staff, and church leaders in the areas of growth, leadership, organizational health, building teams, and ministry effectiveness. Additionally, he engages in leadership coaching with pastors and church boards.

Pastor Jim speaks to business leaders monthly where he shares biblical principles of leadership for secular leaders, managers, and business owners.



**DR. SUSAN COMISKEY, D.Min**

Susan Comiskey is an enthusiastic teacher and speaker. Together with her husband, she has pioneered and led churches in Tonga, Uganda, England, and East Timor. Susan has been involved in both church and community pastoral work for over thirty years. Her passion is missions and her aim is to help others flourish. Susan holds a Master's Degree in Pastoral Leadership (MPL) and a Doctor of Ministry (D.Min) from the Assemblies of God Theological Seminary (AGTS), USA.



**DR. JAY TAYLOR, D.Min.**

Following a decade of pastoral service focused on college ministries, Jay Taylor began working with emerging leaders in the educational setting. He spent three years as a Resident Director at Evangel University in Springfield, Missouri; two years as the Dean of Students at Asia Theological Center in Singapore; and twenty-five years as a professor & administrator at the Assemblies of God Theological Seminary (AGTS) in Springfield, Missouri. Jay enhanced the AGTS community through the development of a student life and spiritual formation department, creating an integrated culture of holistic personal and spiritual growth.

Concurrent with serving at AGTS, for nearly two decades Jay has served as the Vice President of Development at Asia Theological Center (ATC), a fully accredited Bible college in Singapore. ATC has students from nearly 50 countries around the world. (This is a position which Jay still currently holds, and he travels back and forth to Singapore.)

Currently, Jay has partnered with the Assemblies of God World Missions and moved to Kenya to assist in developing ministry training opportunities for East African church leaders. Jay loves working with leaders in these multicultural settings. It's a perfect fit, as he is passionate about equipping students for global impact. Jay's relational leadership style naturally encourages students in their quest to fulfill their God-given visions for life and ministry.
