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## **ABOUT THE LECTURERS**

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### **DR. SUSAN COMISKEY, D.Min.**

Susan Comiskey is an enthusiastic teacher and speaker. Together with her husband, she has pioneered and led churches in Tonga, Uganda, England, and East Timor. Susan has been involved in both church and community pastoral work for over thirty years. Her passion is missions and her aim is to help others flourish. Susan holds a Master's Degree in Pastoral Leadership and

has recently completed her Doctor of Ministry from the Assemblies of God Theological Seminary (AGTS), USA.



### DR. ANALEE DUNN, Ph.D

Dr. Dunn has been involved with Christian education her entire adult life. As a credentialed teacher by the State of Michigan she was instrumental in founding the Bethesda Christian School in 1973. As a staff teacher she taught both elementary and high school students until 1991. Throughout that time period, she was also a Bible teacher in the church. Teaching foundational Catechism classes for over 30 years brought many to a deeper understanding and relationship with Jesus Christ.

Her ability to present Biblical truths in such an understandable fashion led to full time church work. As director of the educational department of Bethesda Christian Church, she instituted many new classes and helped develop a solid teaching core. This led to ministerial credentialing and becoming part of the leadership team at the church. In 2004, following the call of the Lord, she became Senior Pastor.

Known for her ability to teach biblical truths, Pastor Dunn stepped down from her position in 2016 to be able to concentrate on teaching and writing. As a part-time professor at the Detroit Bible Institute, she is continuing to develop curriculum for students interested in biblical studies.

Pastor Dunn has been married to her husband, James, for over 40 years. They have two adult daughters, one son-in-law, and twin grandsons.



### DR. JAY TAYLOR, D.Min.

Following a decade of pastoral service focused on college ministries, Jay Taylor began working with emerging leaders in the educational setting. He spent three years as a Resident Director at Evangel University in Springfield, Missouri; two years as the Dean of Students at Asia Theological Center in Singapore; and twenty-five years as a professor & administrator at the Assemblies of God Theological Seminary (AGTS) in Springfield, Missouri. Jay enhanced the AGTS community through the development of a student life and spiritual formation department, creating an integrated culture of holistic personal and spiritual growth. Concurrent with serving at AGTS, for nearly two decades Jay has served as the Vice President of Development at Asia Theological Center (ATC), a fully accredited Bible college in Singapore. ATC has students from nearly 50 countries around the world. (This is a position which Jay still currently holds, and he travels back and forth to Singapore.) Currently, Jay has partnered with the Assemblies of God World Missions and moved to Kenya to assist in developing ministry training opportunities for East African church leaders. Jay loves working with leaders in these multicultural settings. It's a perfect fit, as he is passionate about equipping students for global impact. Jay's relational leadership style naturally encourages students in their quest to fulfill their God-given visions for life and ministry.
